The Role

Accountable to: Headteacher Campus: Senior Residential/ Non-residential

The role is to plan and deliver suitable Global Studies lessons to British and International Summer School students, developing their cognitive skills and ensuring a positive experience at the Summer School. To collaborate to deliver reflection sessions and support the Summer School programme while supporting the Summer School ethos.

Role Responsibilities

- Deliver a suitable and developmentally appropriate programme in conjunction with the Headteacher and the Academic Manager to a high standard
- Plan and deliver lessons based on a Global Studies framework to students aged 12-17 years old
- Write suitable lesson plans for each taught lesson and submit these by the set deadline
- Complete individual student reports every two weeks and carry out any required administration
- Take class registers/ records as required
- Plan and deliver reflection sessions
- Supervise weekly student lectures
- Attend teacher development sessions weekly
- Assist during meal times and with pastoral duties as needed
- Take part in staff meetings and assemblies as required
- Lead the safe transfer of students, as instructed by the management team
- Lead excursions twice a week as required
- Help students achieve their individual best
- Encourage full student participation and enjoyment as far as possible and learner independence and skill development
- Be involved in the smooth integration of both British and international students
- Be aware of Child Protection issues and act accordingly as necessary, ensuring commitments to welfare are adhered to
- Take all necessary steps to minimise any risk and report any concerns/feedback to the line manager
- Help prepare and conclude the course setting up as required
- Carry out other ad-hoc duties as requested
